

Circular I

To,

Since 1991, the University of Oradea organizes, every two years, the National Symposium on financial and banking history (since 1997 International): "Work, money, banks, culture and politics (18th century - 20th/21st century)". The pandemic prevented us from organizing the 15th edition in 2020-2022. We want to renew our series of meetings in June 2023 with the 15th, jubilee edition.

As in the past, the Symposium will be held in the three sections that have become traditional: Moneylenders, usurers and banks in the modern era (18th century-1918), Credit institutions in the contemporary era (1919-1989), Banks and stock exchanges in the era Decembrist post (1990-present).

We are interested in following the banking phenomenon not only at the level of the Romanian ethno-geographic space, between the Dniester and the Tisa, the sources of the Ceremus-Danube and the Black Sea, with ramifications in the world of Macedonian-Romanians in the Balkans, but also at the level of Central and Eastern Europe - between the Baltic Sea and the Adriatic Sea, the Oder/Rhine, and the Ural Mountains.

The organizers undertake, as always, not to request a participation fee, to bear the cost of accommodation, meals and the trip in the Apuseni Mountains area (Valea Drăganului-Ciucea-Bologa-Rogojel/ Vlădeasa). Participants will only pay their travel expenses.

For the moment, we are waiting, until March 15, 2023, for those who wish to register by providing the following data: name and surname, teaching and scientific degree, place of work, title of the communication in Romanian and English - in the case of Romanian researchers, in English for researchers from abroad, a brief summary of the content of the paper in English.

In the next two Circulars we will return with organizational details (April and May this year)
